

ebrc opens fourth Tier IV data centre

EPT and its subsidiary ebrc opened their fourth data centre at Kayl 28th June. The new 5,200 m² facility offers the highest international standard of fail-safe backup - Tier IV, of which 2,400m² is for the outsourcing of server management. Yves Reding, ebrc's CEO said the 100 million euro facility should help fulfil ebrc's growth predictions of 10%, after having tripled the firm's turnover in four years. The same day, ebrc announced it was opening sales offices in Paris, Brussels and Frankfurt, to help cement Luxembourg's ambition to be the capital of data centre operations. ebrc plans a fifth data centre in Betzdorf, which will be ready in 2012.
